

# Modified Register for Joseph Jellison

## First Generation

1. **Joseph Jellison** was born in 1774 in Shapleigh, ME. He died after 1840 in Brooks, ME.

He appears in Shapleigh town records in late 1790's. Found on 1810 Shapleigh census, as was father. Mentioned in father's 1814 will. Last seen on 1840 Brooks census with young family of son Joseph and Sally (Bowen) Jellison, as well as her widowed grandfather, Samuel Bowen, who died later that year.

As daughters Nancy and Olive were married to the Webb brothers James and Eli A. (as later their younger sister Martha married their younger brother, Edward D Webb, all sons of Ezekial and Sally Webb of Brooks) in late 1825, it can be assumed that the family moved from Shapleigh to Brooks sometime between 1814 and 1825.

He and his line tended to spell the name JELLERSON.

He appears in Shapleigh town records in late 1790's. Found on 1810 Shapleigh census, as was father. Mentioned in father's 1814 will. Last seen on 1840 Brooks census with young family of son Joseph and Sally (Bowen) Jellison, as well as her widowed grandfather, Samuel Bowen, who died later that year.

Joseph married **Lydia Emery** daughter of Reverend or Elder Simon Emery and Mary Hodgdon on 3 Jun 1799 in Shapleigh ME. Lydia was born about 1780 in Shapleigh, ME. She died in 1834 in Monroe, ME. She was buried in Harmony Place Cemetery, Monroe, ME.

She is buried with her parents Simon and Mary Emery, sister Betsy E Ricker and the Ricker family. All gravestones are identical in nature and in a prominent site at the entrance of the cemetery; her gravestone says simply "Lydia Jellerson". There is space beside her for Joseph to be buried with her, albeit without a headstone. Monroe town records have her listed as "Lydia, daughter of Elder Simon Emery, died in 1834" - it goes on to erroneously list her as "wife of Ezekial Webb". (It should be noted that the family of Ezekial and Sally Webb is fully recorded in Brooks) These two families were obviously close and the error an understandable one.

Joseph and Lydia had the following children:

- + 6 M v. **Moses Jellison** was born on 4 Aug 1809. He died on 30 Jan 1892.

- + 10 F ix. **Martha Jellison** died before 1840.

## Second Generation

5. Olive Jellison (Joseph) died on 1 Jan 1828 in Monroe ME.

Olive married Eli A Webb son of Ezekial Webb and Sally --- on 17 Dec 1825 in Brooks ME by Rev Simon Emery.

They had the following children:

- 12 F     i. Sally Webb was born on 7 Oct 1827 in Brooks ME. She died on 1 Jan 1828 in Brooks ME.

6. Moses Jellison (Joseph) was born on 4 Aug 1809 in Shapleigh or Brooks, ME. He died on 30 Jan 1892 in Monroe, ME. He was buried in Monroe Village Cemetery, Monroe, ME.

Very little is known about Moses, other than that he was a farmer and land owner. He and Esther were not deaf, yet three of their children were known to be and many of their grandchildren.

Moses and Esther raised their grand-daughter Mary M (Melissa) Roberts, child of their daughter Mary E (Jellison) Roberts. They also raised grandson Howes Mayo, deaf illegitimate son of their eldest daughter Lucy J (Jellison) Jack Flagg and Howes Mayo Jr. By 1860, Esther's elderly mother Lucy A (Hodges) Ham lived with the family, listed as an 80 year old pauper. Newspaper reflected her death in early 1861. She could be buried with Esther and Joseph in the "50s" row of graves.

Esther was buried beside their son Joseph M Jellison, who was disabled in the Civil War and died of consumption (tuberculosis). Her probate records found at the Waldo County Courthouse in Belfast show the family was relatively poor and unable to handle the legal proceedings. Joseph's Civil War marker records, found at Maine State Archives, show that he was buried in lot # 54, making his mother's lot # 53.

Moses and Sarah both died of influenza on the same day. Eunice (Jellison) Ladd's notes state that Moses and Sarah were born in grave lots #36 and 37, yet neither has a headstone.

By mid 1892, son Isaac had relocated his family from Belgrade to Monroe, where his youngest son Benjamin was born in June. Isaac died in Monroe in 1897 and is presumably also buried at Monroe Center Cemetery without a headstone. Certainly there is enough space near lots #36 and 37 for other graves.

Moses married Esther Ham daughter of Isaac Ham and Lucy Ann Hoages on 29 Apr 1835 in Monroe, ME. Esther was born in Jun 1816 in Hebron/Paris, ME area. She died on 11 Dec 1880 in Monroe, ME. She was buried in Monroe Village Cemetery, Monroe, ME.

Exactly where Esther was born has not been proven, as the records of her children vary greatly. Yet her parents were known to have married in Hebron and some of her siblings were born in that area. presumably she was named for her paternal grandmother, Esther (Garland) Ham.

Moses and Esther had the following children:

Possibly Joseph Moses Jellison.

Civil War records found at Maine State Archives give his date of birth, lot # in cemetery, and middle initial. He enlisted into Co H 4th ME Inf on 9 Nov 1861 with first cousins

Charles H and Horace L Jellerson. He sustained substantial injuries to his right leg (separation of muscles and tendons) while fighting in Maryland and was initially hospitalized in "Armapolis". He was transferred to Alexandria VA, reported as deserted on 17 Mar 1862 and discharged for disability on 28 Mar 1862. He re-enlisted on 28 Dec 1863 into Co A 1st ME HA and was again discharged for disability on 14 Nov 1864. At that time, he was listed as 3/4 disabled and suffering from consumption.

He died of consumption and is buried in lot #54 at Village Cemetery in Monroe beside his mother Esther. His father Moses received a \$12 pension for the family's loss. There is a large granite monument dedicated to the Civil War Veterans of Monroe at the back of the cemetery with the name "Joseph Jellerson" listed as one of the soldiers. When first dedicated, this monument was on a hill in full view of the village center below. Large trees and brush now (2005) obscure the view.

Joseph never married or had children. He was the only son in this family who was not deaf.

- 16 F iv. Sarah Jellison was born in 1849 in Monroe ME. She died on 30 Jan 1892/0042 in Monroe ME. She was buried in Village Cem, Monroe ME .

Died of pneumonia the same day as her father. Never married or had children. Thought to be buried in either lot #36 or 37 without a headstone; her father is in the other grave (notes of Eunice Jellison Ladd).

- + 17 M v. Simon Jellison was born in Sep 1853. He died on 19 Dec 1912.  
+ 18 F vi. Mary E Jellison was born in 1843. She died before 1870.

7. Jane Jellison (Joseph) was born in 1813. She died on 28 Aug 1846 in Brooks ME. She was buried in McLure Cem, Brooks ME.

Jane married Josiah Roberts son of Samuel Roberts and Abigail Wheeler in 1831 in Brooks ME. Josiah was born in 1805 in Brooks ME. He died on 21 Sep 1881 in Brooks ME. He was buried in McLure Cem, Brooks ME.

They had the following children:

- 19 M i. Jonathan D Roberts was born in 1832 in Brooks ME. He died 25 Jun 1913 ae 78y 10m 14d in Belfast ME. He was buried in Rose Cem, Brooks ME.

Age discrepancy; date of birth based on 1850 and 1860 censuses. Age at death taken from death records found on microfilm at Maine State Archives gives a calculated birthdate of 9 Aug 1834. Listed as maimed on 1880 Brooks census, also as a farmer and millwright on different children's birth records. 10 children.

Jonathan married Sarah J Stimpson on 11 Nov 1855 in Brooks ME.

- 20 F ii. Martha J Roberts was born in 1835 in Brooks ME. She died after 1860.  
+ 21 F iii. Catherine Roberts was born on 17 Jan 1836. She died on 21 Apr 1886.  
+ 22 M iv. Levi William Roberts was born on 17 Oct 1837. He died on 14 Nov 1901.  
23 M v. Wellington Roberts was born on 13 Aug 1842 in Brooks ME. He died on 19 Apr 1917 in Searsport ME. He was buried in Village Cem, Searsport ME.

1880 Carmel shows him to be a farmer; death records show him as a sailor who had resided in Northport until the 5 years prior to his death, when he resided in Searsport. 9 children.

Wellington married Maria N Pease on 9 May 1870 in Brooks ME. Maria was born in 1856.

10. Martha Jellison (Joseph) died before 1840 in Brooks ME.

Martha married Edward D Webb son of Ezekial Webb and Sally --- on 15 Feb 1835 in Brooks ME. Edward was born in 1823 in Brooks, ME. He died in 1871 in Brooks, ME. He was buried in Rose Cemetery, Brooks, ME.

1840 and 1850 Brooks censuses show father Ezekial and daughter Eliza living with Edward. He and second wife Ruth had 9 children born in Brooks.

Edward and Martha had the following children:

24 F i. Eliza Webb was born on 12 Nov 1834 in Brooks ME.

11. Joseph Jellison (Joseph) was born in 1815. He died before 1860 in Waldo, ME.

1850 Brooks census: Jellison, Joseph ae 35- wife Sarah J ae 36, kids: Olive A 15, Maria H 12, Charles 9, Horace L 7, Mary J 4/12, Sarah E 4/12.

Joseph married (1) Sarah J Bowen "Sally" on 26 Apr 1835 in Brooks ME. Sarah was born on 20 Sep 1813 in Monroe, ME. She died before 1852 in Brooks, ME.

They had the following children:

25 F i. Olive A Jellison was born in 1835 in Brooks ME.

26 F ii. Maria H Jellison was born in 1838 in Brooks ME.

27 M iii. Charles H Jellison was born in 1841 in Brooks ME.

Resided in Palermo in 1860 after father's death. Served in Co H 4th ME Inf with brother Horace and cousins Joseph Jellison (son of Moses) and Levi Roberts (son of Jane Jellison Roberts). Later transferred to the Navy on 3 Aug 1864.

+ 28 M iv. Horace L Jellison was born on 31 Oct 1843. He died on 30 Jun 1891.

29 F v. Sarah E Jellison was born on 3 Dec 1847 in Brooks ME. She died on 23 Jun 1849 in Waldo ME. She was buried in Piper Family Lot, E. Waldo Rd, Waldo ME.

30 F vi. Mary A Jellison was born on 3 May 1850 in ?Waldo ME. She died 14 Jun 1869 ae 19y 1m 11d in Monroe ME. She was buried in Mt Rest Cem, Monroe ME.

Mary J according to 1850 Brooks census; older twin.

Mary married Nathan H Sterns on 28 Sep 1868 in Jackson ME.

31 F vii. Sarah E Jellison was born on 3 May 1850 in Brooks, ME.

Joseph married (2) Sarah Jane Hall on 19 Dec 1852 in Brooks ME.

Joseph married (3) Nancy J Rolerson on 18 Aug 1855 in Waldo ME.

They had the following children:

32 F viii. Margaret Jellison was born in 1859 in Waldo ME.

## Third Generation

13. **Lucy J Jellison (Moses, Joseph)** was born on 25 Oct 1836 in Monroe ME. She died on 28 Nov 1916 in Belfast ME. She was buried on 30 Nov 1916 in Pattee's Corner Cem (formerly Bartlett), Monroe ME.

Referred to as "Lydia" by nephew John Clifford Jellison SR (1881-1963) in notes taken by his sons, Carl and John JR in 1959-1963. It could be that she was named Lucy to honor her maternal grandmother, Lucy Ann Hoages Ham and nicknamed Lydia to honor her paternal grandmother, Lydia Emery Jellerson, who had died 2 years' prior to her birth.

She was born deaf, as were many of her siblings. This generation was the first with documented deafness in the Jellison family, which has now (2005) passed to an additional 4 generations sporadically. Death records provided her date of birth; it was not recorded in Monroe or Frankfort, where her family was living according to 1840 census. It should be noted that as Monroe was broken off of Frankfort, it could be that the entire family always lived in what is now Monroe.

Worked as a domestic servant for Abraham and Lucinda Knowlton in 1870 E Northport. Her marriage records to second husband list her as born in Monroe and her parents both born in Jackson, mother's name given as "Esther Hamm". Varying censuses list her as having had 3 or 6 children, yet no proof of any children has yet to be found. Children below are possibly hers, neither legitimate.

Referred to as "Lydia" by nephew John Clifford Jellison SR (1881-1963) in notes taken by his sons, Carl and John JR in 1959-1963. It could be that she was named Lucy to honor her maternal grandmother, Lucy Ann Hoages Ham and nicknamed Lydia to honor her paternal grandmother, Lydia Emery Jellerson, who had died 2 years' prior to her birth.

Lucy had the following children:

- 33 M i. **Howes Mayo (III)** was born in 1856 in Monroe ME. He died unknown.

Born deaf; listed as grandson living with Moses and Esther Jellison in 1860 and 1880 Monroe. No further records are found for him after 1880. He was educated at the American Asylum for the Deaf in Hartford CT in 1870, as was his youngest uncle, Simon Jellison; he was listed as "Hawes Mayo age 14 from Maine".

There was a Howes Mayo JR (21 Aug 1835- 13 Mar 1905) living in Frankfort who could have fathered the boy; he married Mary E Moore on 1 Dec 1857 in Monroe and was listed as divorced and living alone in a boarding house in later censuses. He is buried at Lowe Cem in Frankfort.

Born deaf; listed as grandson living with Moses and Esther Jellison in 1860 and 1880 Monroe. No further records are found for him after 1880. He was educated at the American Asylum for the Deaf in Hartford CT in 1870, as was his youngest uncle, Simon Jellison; he was listed as "Hawes Mayo age 14 from Maine".

- 34 M ii. **Harvey Barbour** was born in 1862.

Lived as a farm laborer age 8 along with Lucy Jellison in 1870 E Northport. No further records.

Lucy married (2) **Alfred Jack** son of Nathan P Jack and Abigail Maria Witham on 7 Sep 1876 in Monroe ME. Alfred was born on 26 Jun 1848 in Thorndike ME. He died on 13 Mar 1904 in Monroe ME. He was buried in Pattee's Corner Cem (formerly Bartlett), Monroe ME.

Born deaf and educated at American Asylum for the Deaf in Hartford CT, as was younger brother Dunbar, who lived with Alfred and Lucy according to the 1880 Monroe census until his death on 11 Jan

1904, 2 months' prior to Alfred's. Lucy, Alfred, Dunbar and other Jack relatives are buried at Pattee's Corner Cemetery.

His probate records, located in Belfast, show his estate going entirely to his widow and niece Edith M Cook. No children are listed. Per the same records, Lucy was under the guardianship of Walter Batlett and considered incompetent to handle the probate process.

Lucy married (3) Frank B Flagg on 23 Oct 1909 in Belfast ME. Frank was born in 1849.

She had the following children:

14. Isaac H(am) Jellison (Moses, Joseph) was born<sup>1</sup> on 3 Mar 1838 in Monroe, ME. He died on 29 Jun 1897 in Monroe, ME. He was buried in probably Monroe Village Cemetery, Monroe, ME.

Born deaf; educated at American Asylum for the Deaf in Hartford CT. Information provided from his son John Clifford Jellison SR states that Isaac was a painter and handyman, as well as listed as a farmer on various censuses.

Enlisted as a cook with the rank of private into Co I 4th ME Inf ae 23 on 7 May 1861 (microfilmed record found at Maine State Archives). He listed his birthplace as Ellsworth, possibly to receive a cash bounty- according to Maine State Archives, towns unable to meet their own required number of recruits often offered bounties such as these routinely. There are no other records of him actually serving in the Civil War; he may not have been mustered after his deafness was discovered. A descendant of his son, James George Jellison, had been told by her father that Isaac had been a general in the Civil War. Obviously this is erroneous, but it does lead to speculation that Isaac served or attempted to serve in the war, along with his younger brother and 3 cousins.

While not much is known about his life, this one article from the 5 Jun 1880 edition of the "Daily Kennebec Journal", published in Augusta ME, was found in 2006 online:

'Isaac Jellison, a deaf mute from Belgrade, was before Judge True yesterday morning for assault and battery upon Manley Knowles. Jellison is a stoutly-built, rather intellegent appearing man, and made his defense by pantomime and writing with the lead pencil. Knowles alleged that Jellison got mad at him for for reason or another, and made signs as if he would be delighted to thrash him. Whereupon he (Knowles) put his thumb defiantly upon his nasal organ, and wriggled his fingers at the deaf and dumb man. Jellison followed him to his barn, "busted in the door", and a slight altercation ensued. His Honor dismissed the prisoner on probation.'

He has no headstone at Monroe Village Cemetery, but Eunice Jellison Ladd, a descendant, found records stating that Isaac's father and sister, Moses and Sarah, were buried in lots 36 and 37 in 1892, 5 years prior. They also have no headstones. Examinations of this area of the cemetery shows ample room for all 3 graves and more.

Isaac married<sup>2</sup> Lydia Augusta Lovejoy daughter of Benjamin Lewis Lovejoy and Susan Ann Gordon on 31 Mar 1878 in Monroe, ME. Lydia was born<sup>3</sup> on 18 Feb 1856 in Augusta, ME. She died<sup>4</sup> on 27 Jul 1928 in Augusta, ME. She was buried on 30 Jul 1928 in Cottle Cemetery, Rts 8/11/27, North Augusta, ME.

No headstone. Death records state that she was buried at Cottle Cemetery and according to various census records, she returned to Augusta and lived near Cottle Cemetery with her widowed father Benjamin and brother Cyrus Lewis Lovejoy, after the 1897 death of her husband Isaac in Monroe. Lydia

was deaf, as were her husband and many of their children. Several of her family, including siblings, are also buried at Cottle, some with stones and others without.

In May 2007, I interviewed a Norman Lyon of Summerhaven Road in North Augusta. He was born in January 1921, the son of Percy and — Lyon, and always lived in the same home. Behind his house, which is located at the intersection of Summerhaven and Sanford Roads, is an old and now abandoned sawmill that was Mr. Lyon's sawmill for years. At one time, he had a Paul Lovejoy come out from Augusta proper to work for him. Prior to that, I believe the sawmill may have been the property of Benjamin Lovejoy, per documents located in the Kennebec County Probate Office.

Norman reported that as a young boy, Lydia Jellison and her younger brother "Lou" Lovejoy lived across the road from him in Benjamin's house, across from the abandoned sawmill. In 2007, this house was still standing; it is a single story structure with white vinyl siding. Lydia, who was tall with dark hair, was quite friendly and nice to the local neighborhood children, teaching them sign language and making them delicious homemade molasses cookies. The local boys would also help Lou haul water from a hand dug well, carrying 2 5 gallon pails under his arms to the well. They were considered quite nice neighbors and Norman remembered them both fondly. As homemade "rolled out" molasses cookies were a favorite of Carl Jellison, Lydia's grandson, the story was especially special to hear- John was for the most part estranged from his family and although Carl was almost 8 when his grandmother died, he had no memory of her at all. Carl's sister Lena, the eldest of John's children, did remember the family attending Lydia's funeral in 1928, and that the cemetery was near a lake. Further up Rts 8/11/27 past the cemetery, the highway does run alongside a large lake.

Isaac and Lydia had the following children:

- 37 M     i. **Charles S H (KNOWLES) Jellison** was born on 9 Aug 1878 in Belgrade, ME. He died<sup>5</sup> on 8 May 1959 in Bangor, ME. He was buried on 11 May 1959 in Rose Cemetery, Brooks, ME.

Information provided by John Clifford Jellison SR to his sons stated that Charles, while raised by Isaac, was not his son- Lydia was pregnant when she and Isaac married. John told his sons Carl and John Jr ("Jim") that his older brother was a Knowles.

Lydia had a distant cousin, Charles H Knowles, who lived in the same area as Lydia; it could be speculated that he was the boy's father. Isaac was in an altercation with Charles Knowles' relative, Manley Knowles, in Jun 1880 according to an newspaper article in the Daily Kennebec Journal.

Charles Jellison was not deaf, yet all of Isaac's sons were. He never married or had children, and lived as a farm laborer in Brooks. Documents in the Kennebec Probate show that he tried to "buy out" his aunts and uncles from their portions of his grandfather Benjamin Lovejoy's estate and repaired the buildings to provide a home for his widowed mother.

- 38 M     ii. **John Jellison** was born in 1879 in Belgrade, ME. He died infancy in Belgrade, ME. He was buried in Unknown; possibly Cottle Cemetery, Augusta, ME.

- 44 M viii. Benjamin D Jellison "Benny" was born on 13 Jun 1892 in Monroe, ME. He died<sup>6</sup> in Feb 1970 in Augusta, ME. He was buried in Cottle Cemetery, N Augusta ME.

His marriage records list him as born in Augusta, son of Isaac Johnson, deceased. Monroe records clearly state he was born there, son of Isaac JELLISON. His mother's obit listed her sons as having the last name of JOHNSON; presumably Benny gave the info erroneously.

Published MOCA records for Cottle Cemetery found at Maine State Library do not reflect his gravestone and repeated examinations of the cemetery did not turn up a stone until May 2007, when his gravestone was located behind that of George and May (Jellison) Dudley- May was his older sister.

Benjamin married<sup>7</sup> Edna Haskell daughter of Perley A Haskell and Ida G Smith on 27 Aug 1919 in Sidney, ME. The marriage ended in divorce. Edna was born in 1901 in Sidney, ME. She died<sup>8</sup> on 31 Jan 1977 in Port Orange, Volusia, FL.

17. Simon Jellison (Moses, Joseph) was born in Sep 1853 in Monroe ME. He died on 19 Dec 1912 in Belfast ME. He was buried in Grove Cem, Belfast ME.

Born deaf; educated at American Asylum for the Deaf in Hartford CT per 1870 census.

Simon married Nellie F Chapman on 9 Feb 1882 in Belfast ME. Nellie was born in Lynn MA. She died on 1 Mar 1951 in Belfast ME. She was buried in Grove Cem, Belfast ME.

They had the following children:

- 45 M i. Willie F Jellison was born in 1882 in Belfast, ME. He died on 10 Apr 1885 in Belfast, ME.

His death was recorded in "History of Belfast Vol. II" as follows: 'In the temporary absence of his mother, Willey F. three year old son of Simon Jellison, who lives on Belmont Avenue, set fire to his clothing with matches, causing fatal injuries'.

- 46 M ii. William Fred Jellison was born on 2 May 1885 in Belfast, ME. He died in 1968 in Belfast, ME. He was buried in Grove Cemetery, Belfast, ME.

- 47 M iii. Alvin Moses Jellison was born on 2 Feb 1887 in Belfast, ME. He died on 12 Jul 1971 in Belfast, ME. He was buried in Grove Cemetery, Belfast, ME.

- 48 F iv. Fannie Esther Jellison was born on 14 Sep 1889 in Belfast, ME.

18. Mary E Jellison (Moses, Joseph) was born in 1843 in Monroe ME. She died before 1870 in Monroe ME. The cause of death was possibly childbirth in 1864.

Mary married Levi William Roberts son of Josiah Roberts and Jane Jellison on 25 Oct 1861 in Monroe ME. Levi was born on 17 Oct 1837 in Brooks ME. He died on 14 Nov 1901 in Waldo ME. He was buried in Harding Cem, Rt 131, Waldo ME.
